



With prospects of a long-awaited January thaw comes the happy news of the first Elkhart Historical Society dinner lecture of the 2025 season, to be given Friday, February 21, 2025.



Doors open at 5 p.m., and dinner begins at 5:30 p.m. Among the "news" is the location at The Elkhart Christian Church's Fellowship Community Center at 206 S. Gillett St. in Elkhart, Illinois 62634, where a paved parking lot awaits your vehicle. Also new, in part, is our speaker, Dr. Karl Luthin, who now may qualify as bionic, and is ready to spellbind us with tales of some of the latest historically based movies being created. His is a lifetime filled with equine vetting, re-enacting, and provisioning historically correct equipment, uniforms, guns and horse tack and, on occasion, a special horse. A superb rider, Luthin for years opened the Arabian Costume class at the Illinois State Fair by galloping his horse through the gate into the arena. The list of movies that he has been in or provided for is extensive, and includes: "Gods and Generals," "John Adams" and "Into the West" mini-series, "Gettysburg," "Cold Mountain," and "Lincoln." Luthin has most recently been involved with the filming of a new Civil War movie, "Emancipation," starring Will Smith. Please reserve your seats early for Dr. Karl Luthin's lecture, "Behind the Scenes: Horses in Movie Magic."

The cost per person is \$45, which includes the lecture and dinner featuring a choice of Pulled Pork or Turkey Tetrazzini. We will celebrate Arbor Day on Saturday, April 26, 2025. *More tree seedlings?* Perhaps! We will schedule an "in person" meeting in April and develop more details.

#### News from the <u>Elkhart Trees and Native Plants</u> person *Planning away on these wintery days*.

- Come Mid May to Early June we will be planting the native plant sections out at the
  fishing pond. This was funded by the Illinois Native Plant Society. Last fall Isabelle
  and I placed clean cardboard and the Village helped me cover that with a heavy
  layer of mulch. This spring all the invasives will be dead and the ground ready to be
  planted. This will be FUN and I will be looking for some adult volunteer help. Just a
  couple of hours if you will help!
- Planning another Native Plant Sale this spring. That helps to fund hiring 2 younger helpers that will work mid May-Early August for a total of about 30-40 hours each. All the profits of the sale are held in the Elkhart Community Works non-profit. I will be looking for some adult volunteer help for the plant sale, and again, this is a fun thing!




